## **Accounts Information**

Membership to the Stone Cross Mill Trust has reduced over the years and with it the decline in this source of income. The current financial year has seen the loss of a number of our long serving members. The maintenance bill has been very small thanks to the work of the team who currently work at the Windmill every Monday morning. Some of the gears will eventually need replacing and the team face the difficulty in finding tradespeople who have the necessary skills to undertake this type of specialised work.
