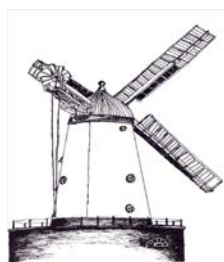


Stone Cross Mill Trust Newsletter March 2017 Issue No 66



The Trust were successful in an application to Wealden District Council for a grant of £6000 to replace the gears and install a water heater for hot drinks. Thanks to the work of the volunteer maintenance team the new gears will be installed as soon as possible ensuring the continual use of the windmill as a source of wholemeal flour for sale to the bread and cake bakers. The generosity of the members and visitors has helped to maintain a steady income for the Windmill. The summer and winter fairs welcomed a large number of old and new members who enjoyed the never ending supply of home-made cakes, jams and eggs. The Harvest Festival at the Windmill in October and Carol Service at St Lukes Church Stone Cross was enjoyed by many members and visitors. The AGM will be held on 16 March 7.00pm at the Windmill.
